

# UPDATED COVIDSAFE PLAN – 20/08/2021

## PRIVATE LESSONS

- If no further restrictions announced over the weekend we will look to re-introduce private lessons as of Monday 23rd of August.
- Private lessons will now be maximum of 30 mins per player and in a 1 student to 1 coach ratio.
- Under the new Public Health Order – all students must be from the Northern Beaches LGA or within 5 km of the venue if outside this LGA.
- Students will touch nothing besides their tennis racquet. The coach will open the gate, pick up the tennis balls, move equipment etc to limit contact crossover. Please bring a glove in case of a serve lesson, if you do not have one a disposable glove can be provided to you.
- Staff will wear masks once they enter the venue and will only remove them if on the other side of the net to the student. Masks are not required to be worn by students on court unless they wish to do so.
- Hand sanitizer stations are located on each court. Both student and coach will be required to use prior and after lesson.
- Venue gates, keypads and handles are being disinfected 3 times a day to ensure player safety.
- The clubhouse is locked and only entry available is for use of the bathroom via 1<sup>st</sup> door entrance (which is sectioned off from the pro-shop). All sales are conducted outside, if you are looking to purchase items please call or knock on door and we'll bring it to you.
- If you are unwell on the day of your lesson, please CANCEL your session, there will be no cancellation fees to do so.
- Our number one priority is safety for all our students, our staff and the community. We will ensure we follow the public health order to the letter and limit the chance of the virus entering and spreading at our facility.

We understand that these decisions may not appeal to everyone and that each Club/Coach is operating under their own interpretation of the Public Health Order. Our Promise to you is that we will go above and beyond to ensure the very best practice is adopted during this time.
